1. Introduction:

2. Paperwork:

- **Team Conflict, Division & Practice Forms due no later than Sunday, May 11th, 2025**
 - Team Conflict Form:
 - Form needed when whole/majority of team cannot make a specific dates/day.
 - Form is **NOT** intended for when 1 or 2 players cannot attend specific dates/day.
 - Cannot guarantee full weeks off.
 - Need to know times that you cannot make on specific days (Example: Mondays 6:00pm to 8:00pm)
 - If you do not turn this form in then FieldhouseUSA will not try to move any games during the Summer Season.
 - Division Request:
 - Select division where you believe your team best fits
 - We use past playing history/records along with coach request to place teams in divisions
 - FieldhouseUSA has final say in divisions
 - Practice Request Form:
 - Please provide 3 options that work for your team.
 - Practices begin at the top of each hour
 - 4pm, 5pm, 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, & 9pm
 - Practices are 55 minutes
 - Each team receives a **TWO** full court for practice for the entire season.
 - Week of 5/19/25
 - Week of 7/7/25
 - Game Move Request Form:
 - Game move request form is needed once game schedule is released and a specific game on the schedule presents a conflict for your team causing the team to forfeit.
 - Games must be moved 1 week prior to their original scheduled game week & both teams must agree on new time.
 - Turn in completed form ASAP if you have a game on your schedule that presents a conflict.
 - If your team did not turn in a team conflict form for the season FieldhouseUSA will not move any of your game move request. By not turning in a team conflict form lets us know that you are free to play games whenever.
 - Game Moves options will be **VERY LIMITED** after the schedule has been released.



3. Rosters:

- All information boxes need to be filled out if players are new/never played at FieldhouseUSA
- Please contact all players on roster within 48 hours of receiving team roster.
 - Call/email them
- You may add players to teams until 3rd week of season. Final day to add players is **Sunday, June 22nd, 2025**.
- **Rosters are the coach's responsibility to make sure correct.**
- **Players can only play on one team per grade level – NO exceptions**

4. Practice Schedule/Practices:

- **Practice Schedule will be released no later than Friday, May 16th, 2025.**
- Scheduled practices will begin the week of May 19th
- Each team will receive **TWO** practices for the entire season, 55-minute, full-court practice.
 - Week of 5/19/25
 - Week of 7/7/25
- Practice preference – priority goes from youngest to oldest (grade-wise) when creating league practice schedule.
- Practices start at the top of every hour
 - 4pm, 5pm, 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, & 9pm
- Teams will not be placed practice schedule if you do not turn in a practice request form.

5. Game Schedule/Games:

- **Game Schedule will be released no later than Friday, May 23rd, 2025.**
- Games will begin the week of May 27th
- Games will end weekend of August 2nd/3rd.
- Teams will be scheduled 8 regular season games.
- Majority of games will be played on weekdays (Monday – Friday). Exception 1 weekend in August (8/2/25 – 8/3/25)
 - Monday - Friday – earliest start 5:30pm
 - Saturday – earliest start 8:00am
 - Sunday – earliest start 11:00am

6. FieldhouseUSA Facility Rules:

- No outside food or drink in the facility (sport drinks/waters ok for players to bring in)
- No outside coolers
- Please hold ALL basketballs, volleyballs, soccer balls, footballs, etc. in the lobby and do not bounce or throw them against the wall while inside the facility.
- Clean up team benches after each game and practice.



7. Coaches

- Coaches **MUST** always wear their coaches' badge on the sidelines
 - Limit to 2 coaches per sideline
 - Referee will not let game start without badges
 - Can be picked up at the front desk.

8. Net Heights/Ball Sizes/Serving Lines:

- Net Heights
 - 1st/2nd Grade - 6'
 - 3rd/4th Grade - 6'6"
 - 5th/6th Grade – 7'
 - 7th/8th Grade – 7'4"
- Ball Sizes
 - 3rd thru 6th Grade Recreational – Volley-Lite
 - 5th/6th Competitive & 7th/8th Grade – Leather Ball
- Serving Lines
 - 1st & 2nd Grade – 10 feet from net. End line is 20 feet from net.
 - 3rd & 4th Grade – 15 feet from net
 - 5th & 6th Grade Recreational – 20 feet from net
 - 5th/6th Competitive & 7th/8th Grade – End Line

9. Playing Time Rules

- Playing Rules
 - Rules can be found online.
 - Teams can start games with 5 players.
 - If a team only has 5 players then any time a team's 6th spot comes up to serve it will be an automatic side out and point for the opposing team.
 - Each team must provide 1 line judge for every game.
 - Players need to play 50% of the game.

Posted Scores

- Scores will be posted online at the end of every night
 - It is the responsibility of each coach to check the scores and notify your correct director if a score is not correct- we will get to it ASAP when informed.
